SRKI NCC Cadets has participated in kite festival organized by Donate life at Lalbhai contractor stadium.

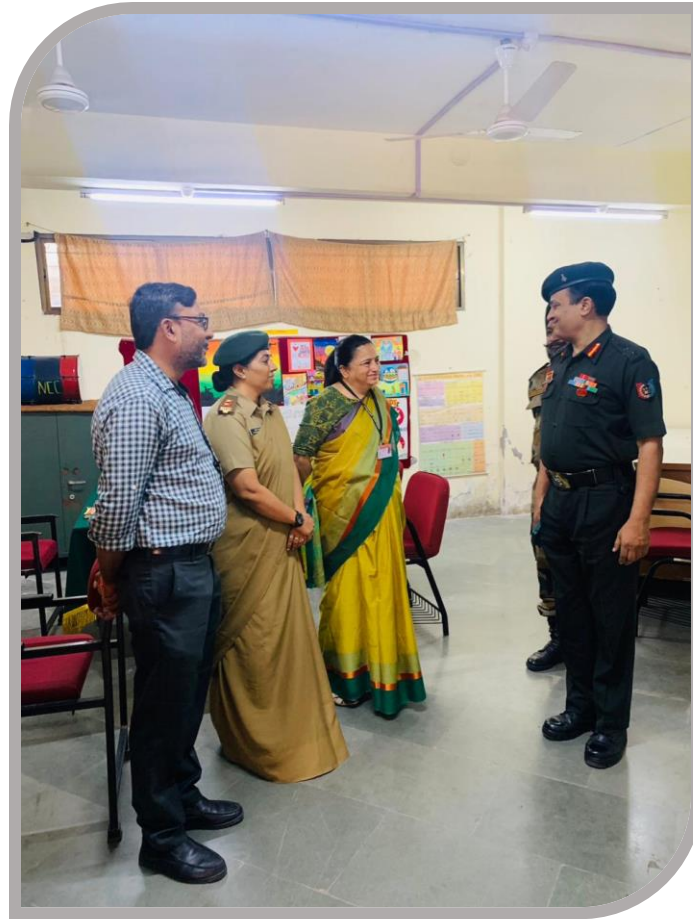
## WHY TO JOIN ARMY (16 march)

## **TSC Camp**



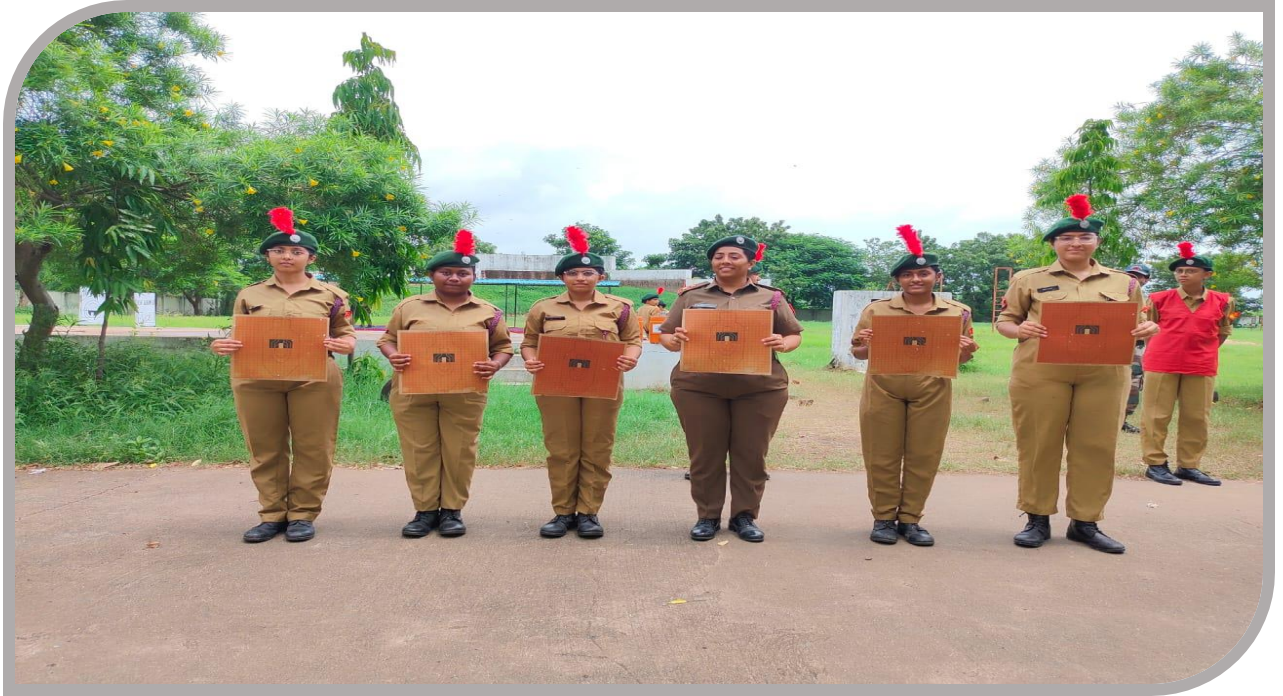
