enhance the employability and facilitate employment opportunities for the students.

Methodology :

- B) The committee prepares Laboratory wise list of old and nonfunctional equipment which require repairs/upgradation, informs the AMC vendor/Service Providers and tracks the status of the work.
- C) The Committee also identifies the future requirements , prepares budget and carries out purchases.

Upgradation undertaken in the year (2018-19):

1. Some old desktop PCs were replaced with Latest core i7 technology PC's.
2. The RAM capacity in all PCs have been upgraded to 8GB.
3. HDMI and VGA new cables has been installed in classroom's.
4. Several internet broadband lines with high bandwidth are subscribed for highspeed internet provision for students as well as staff.
5. Regular renewal of software including Microsoft Academic Alliance and all other software required by curricula as well as for teaching aids.
6. The website was restructured to reflect the goals, activities and their outcomes and for better visibility.
